You will need a working knowledge of substation, transmission and distribution operations and the maintenance/inspection requirements for those operational centers, or knowledge of clerical functions in the office.

DESCRIPTION

This is a comprehensive course for Cascade users responsible for the updating of locations, positions, equipment nameplates, and who manage equipment nameplates and transactions, perform inspections and do field maintenance work.

The following topics are covered:

- Navigator configuration and access for locations and equipment
- Querying, finding and updating data
- Running reports
- Performing inspections
- Performing maintenance and closing work orders
- Creating manual maintenance orders and alerts
- Employee time entry
- Parts and inventory usage

You will be given the opportunity to apply your new knowledge of Cascade software through hands-on examples and case studies.
